



Supply List for Grades 3 to 6

You can buy the following list of supplies at the store of your choice, and we encourage you to reuse what is still good from the previous school year (ex. scissors, etc.). Please note that you may be asked to replace some items during the school year (as needed). ****please label all items with your child's name****

Required Items To Share between Classes

- 2 pencil cases (one for colouring, one for other supplies)
- 1 pencil sharpener
- 2 packs of 24 pencils
- 1 blue pen
- 1 red pen
- 4 erasers
- 3 large glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 pack of highlighters (must include pink, yellow, blue & green)
- 1 pack of pencil crayons
- 1 pack of markers
- 2 whiteboard markers
- 1 large resealable plastic bag for extra supplies**
- 1 USB key
- 1 transparent 30 cm ruler

ENGLISH

- 2" binder
- 1 ½" binder (only if you are in Grade 1 or new to HES)
- 1 pack of dividers
- 1 pack of plastic sheet protectors
- 1 package of lined exercise books (ex. Canada books)
- 4 duo tangs (1 red, 1blue, 1 yellow, 1 green)
- 1 large plastic zippered or snap envelope for homework
- 1 composition (journal) book
- 1 protractor
- 1 cardboard "book box" (magazine box)

FRENCH

- 5 cahiers Canada
- 3 duo-tangs (jaune, bleu, rouge)
- 2 cartables 1 ½ P
- 2 paquets de 5 séparateurs
- 1 paquet de 10 feuilles protectrices
